**SPORTS PERSON OF THE YEAR AWARD -
NOMINATION FORM**

Every year the Club honours our top sports people at the WISC Prizegiving. One of the highest honours is the Sports Person of the Year Award which is given to a person (or team) who have made great sporting achievements during the last 12 months.

WISC Sports Reps will work with coaches, managers and captains of our competitive teams (hockey, cricket, soccer, juniors) to decide which players in their codes will receive the top award for their teams. These then become automatic nominations for the Sports Person of the Year.

WISC members can also participate in the nominations for this award, and we now invite you to put forward your own nomination for someone deserving. The assessment for this trophy will be made by the WISC Awards Committee.

The nominee must be a current paid member and demonstrated one or more of the following:

1. Shown willingness to assist in club actives during the season and contributed towards the development of the club/sport through coaching, leadership or administration.
2. Have an outstanding sporting record/achievement in the current playing year.
3. Have displayed outstanding "sportsmanship" and be a person for whom WISC are proud to be identified (excellence in any area of sporting endeavor including outstanding achievements in sports administration or officiating - refereeing or managing/coaching at national level)
4. The person(s) will typically be a player, but may also be a coach, manager or umpire.
5. Shown examples of good sporting behaviour or role model behaviour during the year.
6. Nominations can be made by any Club member in writing.
